Keeping the tradition alive, Harlan County 4-H continues to host an annual Bike Rodeo to combine safety and fun for youth.

Youth experienced hands-on learning opportunities to learn new and advance old skills focused on safety and fun. 246 youth over the last six years have participated in this program. Youth can connect with others, collaborate with their peers, and participate in friendly competition. The Bike Rodeo also brings key community partners to help sponsor awards, volunteer, and provide youth with caring adult relationships.

### Programs At-A-Glance

- 32 individuals participated in the Prescribe Fire Seminar to learn the importance and benefits of prescribed fires for pasture land for ranchers.
