Programs At-A-Glance

- 3 out of 4 youth ages 5-18 years old were reached by 4-H Youth Development programming via various methods to promote positive youth development and leadership skills.
- 53 Oakdale community members completed a survey as part of the Entrepreneurial Community Activation Process (ECAP). 5 community priorities were identified, and a community better club was established to move on priority projects and grant opportunities.
