Leaders of the newly chartered Washington County 4-H Shooting Sports Club wanted to enable youth to have a safe, education-based environment to learn proper gun handling, model sportsmanship, and strengthen life skills. At the end of its inaugural 4-H season, the club rose to 40 youth members and three new volunteers, generated four new partnerships, and hosted two new contests. “My goal for this club was to educate kids so they can enjoy shooting sports for a lifetime. We’ve done just that,” Kerry Huntley, 4-H Club Leader.
