1. Complete the Dodge County 4-H Foundation College Scholarship application form.
2. Submit your current "4-H Career Portfolio" with your application.
3. Must be a current high school senior, graduating in the spring of 2018.
4. Plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college (in-state or out-of-state) in the fall of 2018.
5. Award based on 4-H record and not High School academic record.
6. Have been an active Dodge County 4-H member for the past four consecutive years.
7. Approved and Recommended for application by 4-H leader with signature on application form. (a separate letter of recommendation is not required)
8. Future career goals may be in any discipline.
9. Winners names will be forwarded to applicant's respective High School for inclusion in graduation announcements.
10. Dodge County 4-H Foundation will award scholarships after enrollment in college and directly to the college or university. Applicant must provide proof of enrollment as a full-time student to the Dodge County Extension Office.
