CONTEST GUIDELINES:

- The livestock judging contest classes will consist of beef, hogs and sheep. The number and kind of classes will be decided the day of the contest.
- Teams will consist of three or four members. Division of team (senior, intermediate, junior) will be determined by the oldest member of the team.
- The top three scores from each team will be used for team scores/awards.
- Individual work will be stressed at all times. Anyone caught copying will be eliminated from the contest.
- AWARDS will be presented to the Champion and Reserve Champion Judges in the Senior, Intermediate and Junior Divisions. Medals will be awarded to the Champion and Reserve Champion Teams in the Senior, Intermediate and Junior Divisions.
- CLOVER KIDS DIVISION: Clover Kids 4-H members may participate in the Livestock Judging Contest non-competitively. They will receive a participation ribbon and \$0.50 premium. Clover Kids 4-H members will NOT be allowed to compete as part of a team.

ORAL REASONS CONTEST

There is an "Oral Reasons" (one set) portion of the Livestock Judging Contest.

The oral reasons (one set) will be an optional opportunity. The oral reasons will be scored separately and will not be counted for the judging (classes) portion of the contest. However, the contestant must have judged in the contest to compete. In addition, tie-breakers may be based on class scores.

If competing, 4-H and FFA contestants must pre-register (Friday 12 p.m.-1:30 p.m. at 4-H Office).

AWARDS: A gold medal will be awarded to the highest scoring individual for the Senior, Intermediate and Junior Divisions. A Clover Kid ribbon will be awarded to all clover kids who participate.

FASHION REVUE GUIDELINES:

All 4-H members participating in the Fashion Revue are required to model their project on Thursday, July 30 in the Public Show and to exhibit their clothing project for construction during the Dodge County Fair.

FOR MODELING: Each participant will be assigned a specific time for judging on Monday, August 1 and will be notified by letter as to their assigned time for judging.

FOR CONSTRUCTION: The same clothing garment that was entered in the Fashion Revue on Monday, August 1 must be entered at the Dodge County Fair on Tuesday, August 2 (6:00-8:00 p.m.) or Wednesday, August 3 (7:30-9:00 a.m.) and be displayed during the duration of the Dodge County Fair. Release of exhibits is scheduled for Sunday, August 7 (8:00 - 9:00 p.m.).

The Fashion Revue judging will take place on Monday, August 1 beginning at 1:00 p.m. (by appointment) and will be located at Mohr Auditorium in Scribner. Participants must be at Mohr Auditorium in Scribner 15 minutes prior to being judged. Judging of clothing construction will NOT be provided during the Fashion Revue.

Fashion Revue participants are required to model in the Public 4-H Fashion Revue scheduled Thursday, August 4 at 6:30 p.m. in the Exhibit Hall at the Dodge County Fairgrounds.

Participants will be lowered one ribbon placing if not modeling at the Public 4-H Fashion Revue.

ENTRY LIMIT: 4-H members are eligible to compete in more than one Fashion Revue class provided they are enrolled in two or more project areas with a maximum of THREE entries. However, the 4-H'er is limited to model one outfit per project area.

- The GRAND CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION Awards will be selected by qualified Clothing/Fashion Revue Judges. In addition State Fair Representatives will be chosen to go on to the State Fair along with alternates (if 10 - 18 years old on January 1, of current year) who will represent Dodge County in the State Fair Fashion Revue. The number of State Fair contestants are based on our county quota (clothing project enrollment).

- The NOVICE AWARD will be selected by qualified Clothing/Fashion Revue Judges. 4-H members eligible for this award are youth ages 8 - 11 years old on January 1 of current year AND competing for the first time in the Dodge County Fashion Revue in Clothing Level 1, Beyond the Needle, and/or Shopping in Style Divisions.

➤ Entry is a decorated item by the 4-H'er.

STEAM CLOTHING 1 - FUNDAMENTALS

(NOT Eligible for State Fair)

NOTE: Only eligible for Dodge County Fair.

Class 905 Sewn project in Clothing Level 1, non-wearable

Class 920 Simple Top, Simple Bottom OR Simple Dress

➤ Entry is a simple top or bottom.

➤ 4-H'ers enrolled in or completed Clothing Level II or Clothing Level III are not eligible to exhibit in Clothing Level I.

BEYOND THE NEEDLE

Class 10 Embellished Garment(s) with an Original Design Garment is created using intermediate or advanced techniques as defined in the project manual. Designs are the original idea of the 4-H'er using the elements and principles of design to make an original statement.

Class 15 Garment Constructed From Original Designed Fabric. Fabric yardage is designed first, then a garment is constructed from that fabric. Other embellishments may be added.

Class 20 Textile Arts Garment(s) Garment is constructed using new unconventional materials. Examples: rubber bands, plastic, duct tape.

STEAM CLOTHING 2 – SIMPLY SEWING

Class 30 Constructed STEAM 2 Garment(s)

Possible types of garments include: Dress; Romper or Jumpsuit; OR Two-Piece Outfit (skirt with top, vest, or lined/unlined jacket; jumper and shirt; pants or shorts Outfit (pants or shorts with top, vest, or unlined/lined jacket).

A purchased top can be worn to complete a skirt, pants, or shorts outfit with a vest or unlined jacket.

4-H members who have enrolled in or who have completed STEAM 3 projects are not eligible to enter STEAM 2.

Nightshirts, flannel lounging pants, or any other types of loungewear can NOT be modeled.

STEAM CLOTHING 3 – A STITCH FURTHER

Class 40 Constructed STEAM 3 Garment(s)

Possible types of garments include: Dress or formal; Skirted Outfit (skirt with shirt, vest, or lined/unlined jacket OR jumper and shirt); Pants or Shorts Outfit (pants or shorts with shirt, vest, or lined/unlined jacket); Romper or Jumpsuit; Specialty Wear (swim wear, costumes, western wear-chaps, chinks, or riding attire); OR Non-tailored Jacket. Additional pieces with jacket or coat may either be constructed or purchased.

Tailored Blazer, Suit Jacket, or Coat. Additional pieces with blazer, jacket or coat may either be constructed or purchased. A purchased top can be worn to complete a vest or jacket outfit with a skirt, pants or shorts.

Nightwear or loungewear can NOT be modeled.

SHOPPING IN STYLE

(8 & 9 year olds on Jan 1, 2016 are NOT Eligible for State Fair)

Class 60 Purchased Outfit and Written Report SF184

Exhibitors modeling in this division/class are ages 8-18 years old January 1 of the current year

➤ Participants must be enrolled in the Shopping in Style 4-H Project to enter this Fashion Revue class.

➤ Participants will be allowed to model in both the constructed fashion show and the purchased garment (Shopping In Style) fashion show. This also applies to the State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue. Therefore, a 4-H'er may be selected to represent Dodge County in the Shopping in Style 4-H Fashion Show and in the (regular/construction) 4-H Fashion Show.

ONE 4-H member will be selected to represent Dodge County in the Shopping in Style 4-H Fashion Show at the Nebraska State Fair.

Participants modeling in this class are REQUIRED to complete a "4-H Fashion Show – Purchased Garment(s) – Shopping in Style" information form. This form is to be completed and presented at time of Fashion Revue check-in on Monday, August 1. Forms are available at the Nebraska Extension Office in Fremont.
