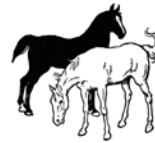

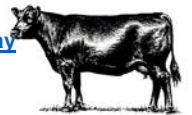


### West Central Youth Animal Science Field Day

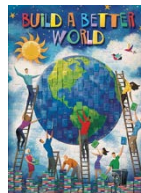
