FUN WITH FLEECE!

You need to bring:

- ♦ 1 pillow form or bed pillow
- ♦ 2/3 yard EACH of two different colors or double Faced Fleece Fabric for a pillow. This is the minimum amount you need for one pillow- and it is actually enough for 2 pillows.
- ♦ If you want to make a blanket, you will need 2 yards of each type of fleece
