Required Qualifications:

- Master's degree required; one degree in youth development, agricultural or science education, or closely related field. Master's degree must be completed by start date.
- Successful experience teaching in a formal or non-formal setting.
- Demonstrated communication skills (publications, presentations, web and social media).
- Experience and demonstrated ability in working with youth and youth organizations including understanding of positive youth development and youth program management.
- Experience working with individuals, coworkers, partnering organizations, and teams to accomplish individual and/or group goals, as evidenced by college, career, and/or community activities.
- Minimum of two years' experience working in youth development programs.
