• STATE 4H COMPETITION AGE CHANGE

New this year! All members who are at least **9 years** of age on January 1st will be eligible to participate in 4-H in-person events (live animal shows, fashion shows, and contests) at the Nebraska State Fair. This does NOT apply to horse events.

NEW LIVESTOCK INFORMATION

Starting in 2023, all livestock in contention to exhibit at the Nebraska State Fair will be required to submit a DNA nomination. This includes all 4-H and FFA breeding livestock, market livestock, and feeder calves. Any DNA nomination submitted through Show Stock Manager will also be eligible for exhibition at the Aksarben Stock Show. DNA nominations will be \$7.00 per animal. All animals will automatically be eligible for both breeding and market-no additional fees or double payments will be required. DNA nominations for the Nebraska State Fair are due on June 15, 2023.



4-H ENROLLMENT OPEN <u>V2.4HONLINE.COM</u>

4-H Enrollment is open for 2023. All youth involved in 4-H must be enrolled by June 15th in order to participate in the County and State Fair this summer. There is an enrollment

fee of \$10.00 per youth, \$20.00 per family. Re-enrolling families will use the same username (email) and password as before. For new families, go to the website and create a new profile.

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is a national multi-species quality assurance program for youth ages 8 to 21 with a focus on three core pillars: food safety, animal wellbeing, and character development. This training is required for all food producing animal or livestock project members. Food producing and livestock projects include beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, dairy goat, meat goat, poultry and rabbit.

Members will go to www.yqca.org and log in using their 4HOnline login. Members must have an Active status with 4hOnline to be able to log in and complete the courses.
