Did you know that 2025 will be the 150th year of the Fillmore County Fair? The Fillmore County fair looked much different back then. For example, 4-H wasn't established till 1902, so the exhibits were much different! Throughout the next year, we are going to explore some of the popular exhibits that were displayed throughout the years! Each month will have a different theme and will either have a workshop, appointment time, or take home kit.


