

Kerry Bryant Memorial Scholarship

One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500. The scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school Senior. The Bryant Family and Scholarship committee's decision is final. Funds for this scholarship will come from the Kerry Bryant Memorial Fund.

REQUIREMENTS:

The applicant must be an active member of Cherry County 4-H, including their senior year of high school. Graduating high school seniors that will be enrolled in a college or vo-tech school can apply. The applicant must have exhibited at a county contest in livestock (beef, swine, sheep, goats) and/or horse at least 1 year and competed in shooting sports 2 of their 4 high school years.

Applications are due to the Cherry Count Extension Office, **postmarked by March 31st, 2024**. Applications may be dropped off at the Extension Office or submitted electronically to mgarwood3@unl.edu. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure the electronic submission is received.

Your application must be typed. Address the below points in your application.

1. Describe the most important things you learned from your 4-H livestock or horse projects and competing in shooting sports.
2. Describe your future goals and education plans.
