## **Kerry Bryant Memorial Scholarship**

One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500. The scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school Senior. The Bryant Family and Scholarship committee's decision is final. Funds for this scholarship will come from the Kerry Bryant Memorial Fund.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

The applicant must be an active member of Cherry County 4-H, including their senior year of high school. Graduating high school seniors that will be enrolled in a college or vo-tech school can apply. The applicant must have exhibited at a county contest in livestock (beef, swine, sheep, goats) and/or horse at least 1 year and competed in shooting sports 2 of their 4 high school years.

Applications are due to the Cherry Count Extension Office, <u>postmarked by March</u> <u>31st, 2024</u>. Applications may be dropped off at the Extension Office or submitted electronically to <u>mgarwood3@unl.edu</u>. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure the electronic submission is received.

- 1. Describe the most important things you learned from your 4-H livestock or horse projects and competing in shooting sports.
- 2. Describe your future goals and education plans.
