Important things to know:

- **May 15** – Summer Sign-Up form & Special Foods/Cupcake War pre-entry DUE.
- **June 1** – State Horse Show entry deadline (ID forms and Levels due)
- **June 3** – All county livestock and horse ID forms DUE. Market livestock photos due with forms. *Please notify the Ext. Office if you plan to nominate for State Fair so we can help!*
- **June 15** - Make sure you enroll in 4-H by this date if you would like to exhibit your items at Fair: v2.4honline.com (\$5 fee due to Ext. Office)
- **June 15** – State Fair Livestock Nominations DUE.
- **June 28** – Clothing Day pre-entry DUE
- **July 11** – Clothing Day where all textile projects are judged prior to Fair (includes barn quilts) Clover Kid textiles will be judged August 7 at Fair.
- **July 15** – Pre-fair entry forms, horse levels, YQCA and stocker feeder photos DUE.
- **August 2-11** – Cherry County Fair activities
