### **DEAN BRANDT**

Dean Brandt was a county official in Gage County throughout most of his adult life. He served as Clerk of the District Court recording court records and proceedings. Dean was a member of the Beatrice Kiwanis Club for 36 years. He believed in a stronger community and exercised those beliefs through service to his community in Kiwanis. The Kiwanis motto is "We Build". I think that was on Dean's mind when he left money in his will for Kiwanis to help support this \$1000.00 scholarship which we have chosen to give in his name.

### **RALPH ROSZELL**

Ralph Roszell was a long time photographer and businessman in Beatrice. Ralph ran a photography shop and office supply store until the time of his death at age 96. The Beatrice Kiwanis Club honors Ralph with a \$1000.00 scholarship given in his name to a Beatrice High School graduating senior. Ralph was a charter member of our club in 1921 and was active until the time of his death 62 years later. Ralph always held high the ideals of Kiwanis in building a stronger community by investing in the education and training of the citizens.

### **Application Requirements**

Applicants must have attained a 3.0 average on the 4-point equals an "A" scale.

Applicants need to submit:

- 1) Attached application form, signed and dated
- 2) Life experiences (maximum 1 page)
- 3) Typed or printed essay of not more than one page
- 4) One letter of recommendation, employers or volunteer coordinators preferred, but teachers are okay

The essay should deal with your current and future goals in your education and career plans. We want to hear about your personal goals. We also want to see you realize those goals, which is why we have made these scholarships on-going for your college career. Your application will be considered for both scholarships, but an individual may not win both scholarships.

The Kiwanis Club will base their selections on need, goals for your studies, achievements, high school activities, Key Club participation, and community activities.

The two \$1500.00 scholarships will be paid to the winning applicants by the Beatrice Kiwanis Club as follows: \$750.00 to the Southeast Community College as school begins in the fall, then \$750.00 the next school year, provided the applicant remains a student in good standing, provides proof of enrollment each year. A visit the Kiwanis Club once per year to report on their progress and learn about career opportunities in our community is suggested.
