Hunger affects 780 people in Antelope County. To help combat this, a donation garden was started in Neligh where all produce harvested was donated to those in need.

Programs At-A-Glance

- 67% of 7th/8th graders have participated in Real World Money. This interactive financial management program prepares students to make sound financial decisions as adults.
- 72% of youth in Antelope County have been reached by clubs, school enrichment, after-school programs, and camps.

168 low-income individuals served via produce donations.

1,662 LBS of fresh produce donated to our neighbors in need.

1 IN 3 age eligible youth are enrolled in the Antelope County 4-H Program.
