

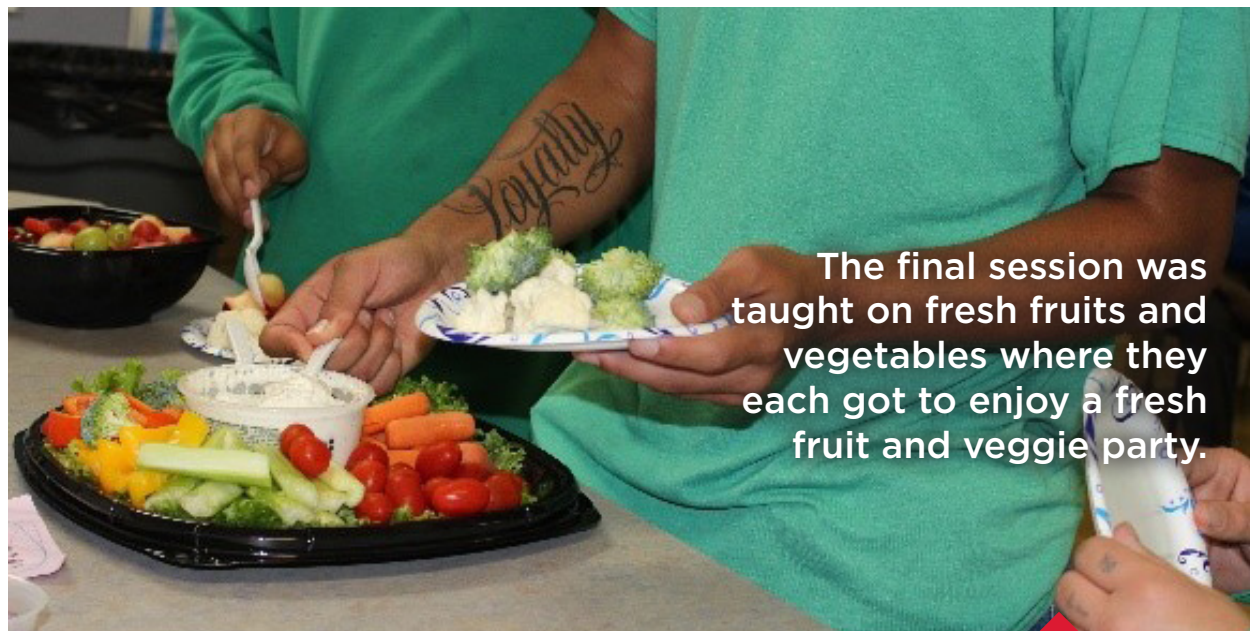

2021 Impact At-A-Glance



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The final session was taught on fresh fruits and vegetables where they each got to enjoy a fresh fruit and veggie party.

The Youth Rehabilitation and Treatment Center (YRTC) partnered with NEP and Nebraska Total Care to implement the Marathon Kids program. YRTC students ran a total of 1,094 miles with an average of 2 marathons per student. Staff reported fewer behavior issues with students while engaged in this program. “Running makes me clear my head, and then I can go back and make better decisions.”

Programs At-A-Glance

- 26 youth explored entrepreneurship concepts by developing and selling products at the farmers' market through a school enrichment program.
- Twenty childcare providers took Pyramid Model for Social-Emotional Learning 6-hour Mindfulness training.

429 4th-grade students learned about engineering and problem solving skills through school enrichment.

26 youth learned about raising and showing animals during the Lamb and Goat camp. 12 showed their lambs and goats at the county fair.

6 On-Farm Research studies completed with growers and crop consultants.
