## 2021 Impact At-A-Glance

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Nebraska Extension facilitated AgSplosion, an ag literacy program for youth in Cheyenne and Deuel Counties. Over 119 youth participated in the event.

AgSplosion is an ag literacy program that helps students learn more about the crops and livestock produced in Nebraska and what they are used for. Throughout the day students rotated to a variety of different stations that gave them an opportunity for a hands-on experience related to a wide variety of ag topics. One teacher that attended said, “They now have more knowledge about ag to describe and help the others in the community/school understand.” Another teacher stated, “Hopefully, more will think about a future in the ag industry by becoming involved in 4-H, FFA, and college.”

### Programs At-A-Glance

- Extension Educators supported businesses and chambers by providing a Red Carpet Hospitality Training Event.
- Since 2018, Master Gardeners raised 4,000 lbs. of produce valued at \$4,300, supporting 804 residents through local food pantries funded by Growing Together Nebraska Grant.

**1260+** Youth were involved in a 4-H program in Cheyenne and Deuel Counties.
