Programs At-A-Glance

- **Ranch Handbook.** Ranch Handbook covers topics from records to fencing and everything in between. Videos are posted online for easy access.
- **Animals Inside and Out.** After completing the 4-H Animals Inside & Out field day, 84% of 3rd and 4th graders said they better understand where their food comes from.
