- **Learning Child:** A total of 4412 adults and 41,689 children were reached through childcare training programs statewide.
- **Farm Safety:** 406 youth learned how to be safe in our rural communities in Kearney/Franklin Counties through Farm Safety Programs in collaboration with 4 local FFA Chapters in 2021.
