Programs At-A-Glance

- **Go NAP SACC:** To improve the quality of early care through improving nutrition and physical activity. 116 childcare providers and the children in their care have benefited.
- **4-H Youth Development programs** offer a variety of in-school, after school, and summer programming reaching 87% of Garden County and 51% of Morrill County youth.

54 Food service professionals were trained through ServSafe providing 9000 safely prepared meals a day.

87 Farmers and ranchers attended Private Pesticide Safety and Chemigation Education Classes.

95% of youth attending Ag Literacy programs have a better understanding of where their food comes from.
