Programs At-A-Glance

- The Growing Together Nebraska garden received the Green Leaf Award from the City of Norfolk. Funded by \$11,097 in grants, it has donated >7,400 lbs of produce the past three years.
- The Ag Literacy Festival was recreated as a virtual experience for second and third grade youth. Experiencing life on the farm broadened their exposure to agricultural production.
