

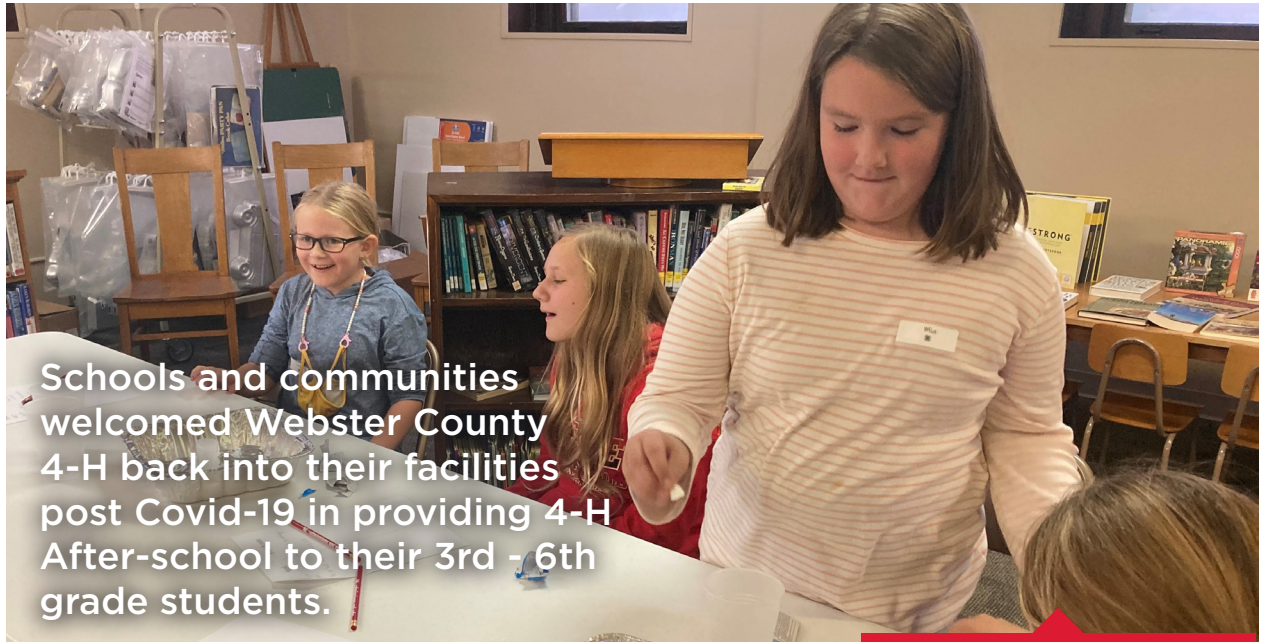
# Webster County

## 2021 Impact At-A-Glance



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Schools and communities welcomed Webster County 4-H back into their facilities post Covid-19 in providing 4-H After-school to their 3rd - 6th grade students.

Webster County 4-H staff listened to the local request to return 4-H After-school into their communities in fall 2021. Schools & communities welcomed Webster County 4-H back into their facilities. Each of the three communities received three consecutive weeks of programming totaling almost 5 hours of instructional programming in each location. Over 90% of the students were previous participants from pre-Covid-19. One teacher shared “I am so glad we are providing this opportunity for our students.” A participant stated they enjoy after-school as they get to be with friends and learn.

### Programs At-A-Glance

- 95% of farmers that attended pesticide safety classes more frequently use methods to reduce drift of pesticides from crop fields.
- Programs provided at no charge or covered by Extension scholarships and grants saved Nebraska childcare providers \$18,225 to attend programs such as Read For Resilience.
