

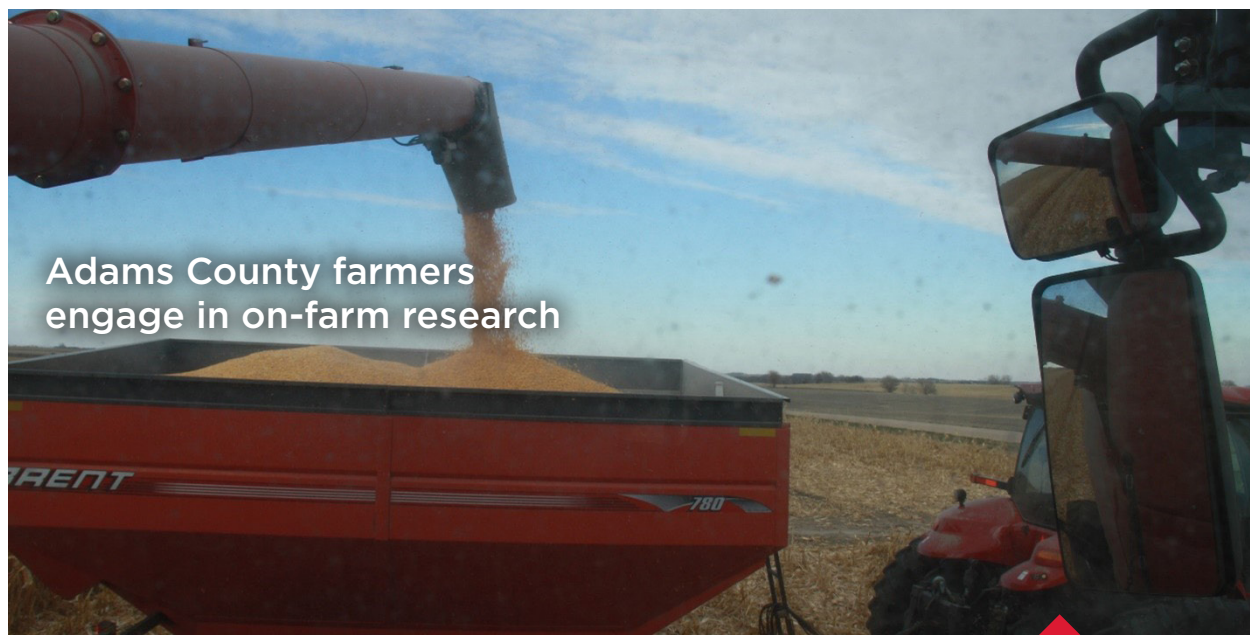

Adams County farmers engage in on-farm research

On-farm research projects were highlighted during a session for the 85 participants of the 2022 Hastings Crop Production Clinic. An attending crop consultant said, “The on-farm research presentation helped me realize the relevance of production questions that my farmer clients and I have been asking. This idea resulted in the deployment of a local on-farm research plot. The participating farmers valued the simplicity of the project design and the ease of execution. One of the farmers said, “I welcome the opportunity to test products on my farm where we can gather reliable, unbiased results.”

Programs At-A-Glance

- 1,501 youth reached through direct Nutrition Education Program classes in every Hastings Public School school grades 3-12.
- 1 in 2 age eligible youth in Adams County had a 4-H experience through school enrichment, after-school, special interest and/or traditional 4-H programs.
