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Understanding what it cost to produce value is the primary objective of the Unit Cost of Production Workshop. Calculating the value of land and each operation separately will be a big factor in future decisions. After the third year of the workshop in the BKR area 100% of attendees would recommend the workshop to other producers. Giving cattle(wo)men the space to shift paradigms and come to conclusions such as: "This workshop really opened my eyes. Breaking the ranch into the different segments is very interesting. It's making those tough decisions a high value by-product of the content."
