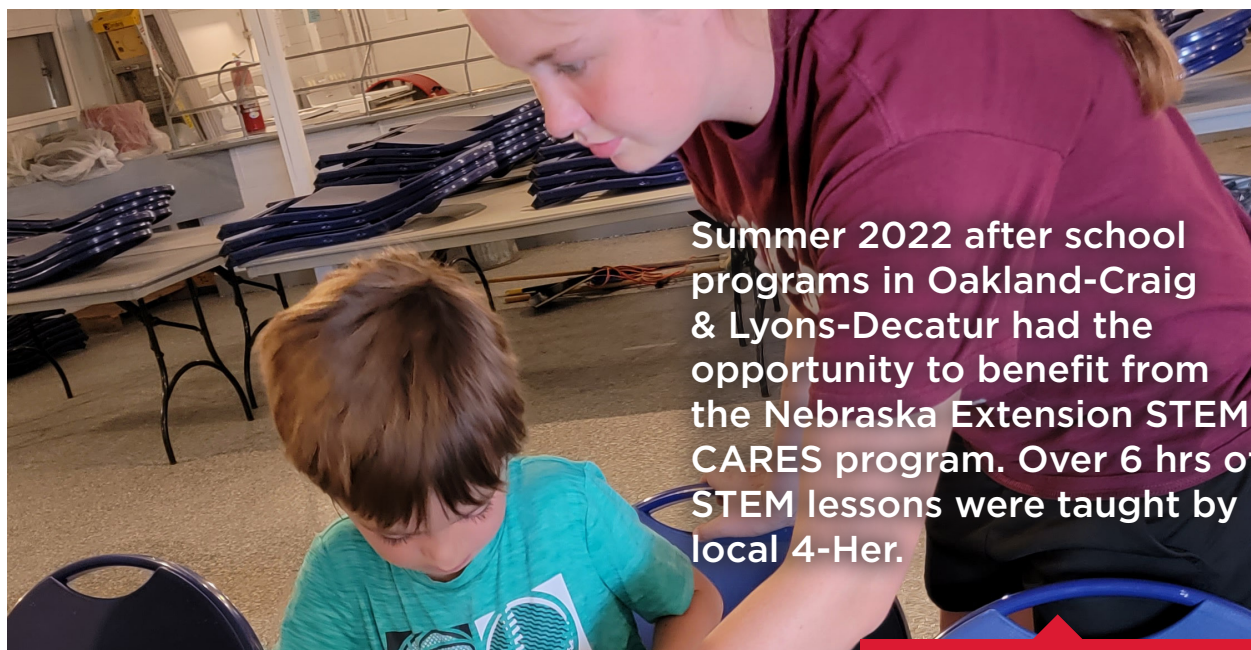


# Burt County Impact At-A-Glance
