Dakota County Voices for Food leads the state in volunteer engagement in the Growing Together Nebraska Project. Volunteers in Dakota County are engaged in the process, because of the sense of community we create in volunteering. Volunteers are valued, recognized, and their efforts are acknowledged with direct impact in the community. Volunteers see the results of their efforts, by the people who now have access to fresh food because of the work they do. In Dakota County, food access is a community effort.

Programs At-A-Glance

- 4-H School Enrichment lessons reached over 915 students in Dakota County. Lessons focused on robotics, butterflies, entrepreneurship, STEM, nutrition, and leadership.
- Dakota County established 4-H Ambassadors to empower teen leaders with the knowledge and skills to promote and advocate for Nebraska 4-H at the local and state levels.
