

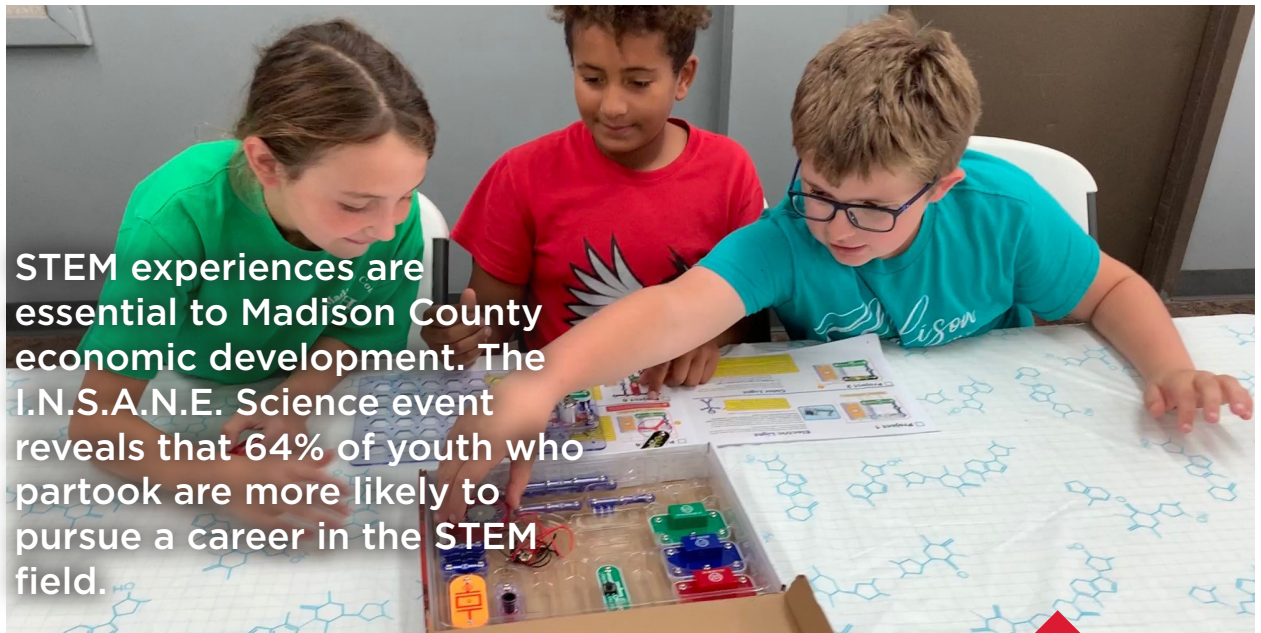

STEM experiences are essential to Madison County economic development. The I.N.S.A.N.E. Science event reveals that 64% of youth who partook are more likely to pursue a career in the STEM field.

Tyler, a youth participant, knows the future demand for STEM careers will exceed supply. Therefore, he was anxious to attend the “Imagine Now! STEAM and Nebraska Extension (I.N.S.A.N.E.)” event to learn about STEM. Over 630 youth were engaged with experiences to enhance critical thinking and problem-solving skills while inspiring them to pursue jobs in STEM. Tyler shared “I learned about circuits and used simple items to make a flashlight! I took the skills gained and built a circuit board as a project for the fair. Nebraska Extension helped me discover my future career as an electrical engineer.”
