## Impact At-A-Glance



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The annual AgCiting Ag Festival was held for 216 4th grade students, learning about agriculture that is happening in Nebraska surrounding their homes, schools, and communities.

Students rotated through 9 sessions learning about different commodities, machinery, and careers in agriculture. "I think this is a great opportunity for students to learn more about agriculture in Nebraska and how it impacts their daily lives. There are a lot of students who don't realize where all of their food comes from, or how much goes into the production of livestock or farming. This is a great way for them to get a hands-on approach to how it all comes together," teacher Cassidy said.
