

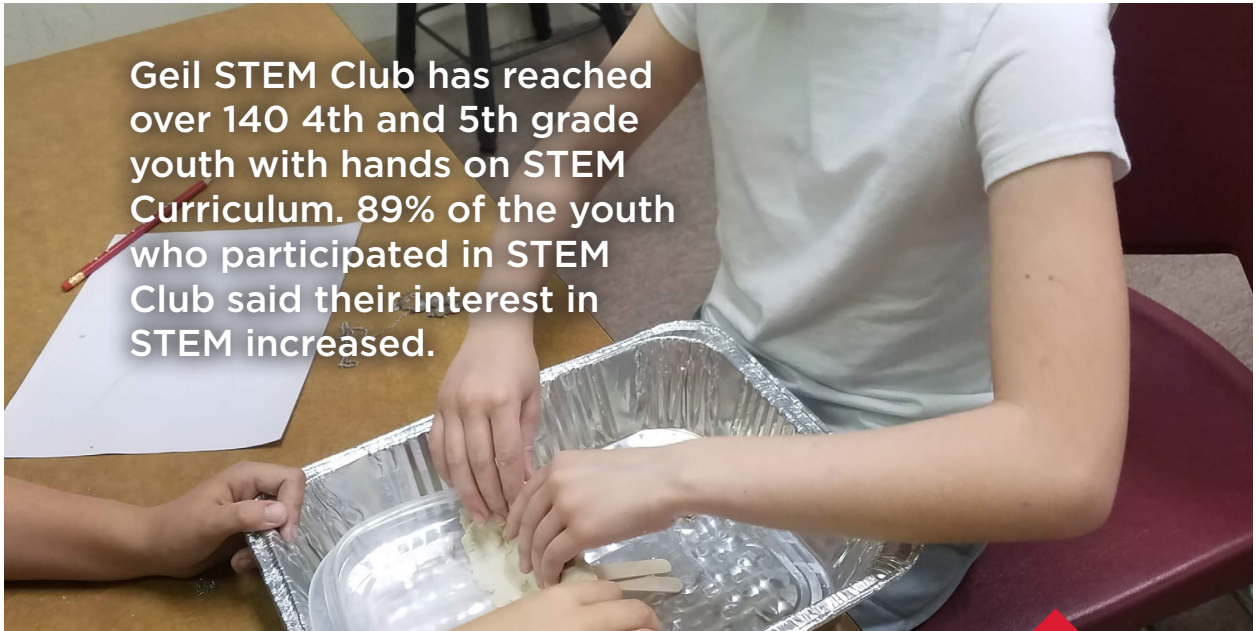

Impact At-A-Glance



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Geil STEM Club has reached over 140 4th and 5th grade youth with hands on STEM Curriculum. 89% of the youth who participated in STEM Club said their interest in STEM increased.

In 2019, a partnership began between Nebraska 4-H and two Gering elementary teachers looking to provide their 4th and 5th grade students additional STEM opportunities. From this partnership the Geil STEM Club began. Each year the club provides Geil youth six 4th grade lessons and eight 5th grade lessons a variety of STEM topics. Lisa Gass and Crystal Venable had this to say about the program, “This club extends classroom learning and introduces topics not covered in our curriculum. Nathan challenges our students to think on a higher level.” In the words of the Geil Students, “It was awesome!”

Programs At-A-Glance

- Water Education for Tomorrow (WET) for Panhandle 5th grade schools totaled 204 individuals. “Thanks for telling us how much water you need for different crops.”
- 322 early childhood providers participated in professional development indirectly reaching 1,378 children. Provider stated, “You give me hope for my career path.”
