Having an up-to-date estate plan is a necessity for farmers and ranchers, but there are a variety of reasons that many do not. In March of 2022, Seward County hosted an estate planning workshop featuring the tools and strategies to effectively plan, start, and complete plans. ### Programs At-A-Glance

- The annual Ag Literacy Field Day experience reached 190 third and fourth graders. Students learned about the importance of agriculture and where their food comes from.
- Seward County Jr. Leaders – 27 teens took part in the 4-H youth leadership program. Teens taught workshops, made blankets for Foster Friends, and held leadership roles at county events.
