

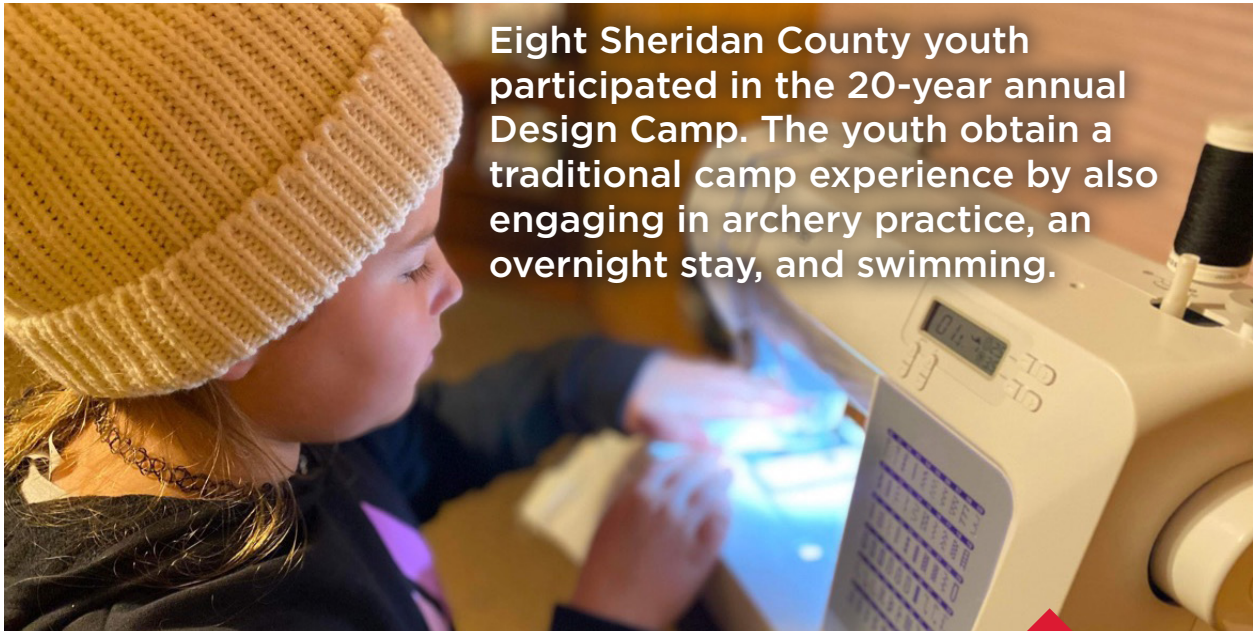

Impact At-A-Glance



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Eight Sheridan County youth participated in the 20-year annual Design Camp. The youth obtain a traditional camp experience by also engaging in archery practice, an overnight stay, and swimming.

Youth participants not only learn how to sew basic projects, but they practice design techniques while creating their very own garments. A first-time sewer started attending the Extension Office sewing activities in 2021. This past year she has sewn independently at home as well as for others. At Design Camp, she helped beginning sewers with their projects as her way to give back. Due to the techniques and knowledge, she has gained throughout the sewing program and camp, she hopes to start her own sewing business.

Programs At-A-Glance

- **Real World Money:** Participants learn how to write checks, balance ledgers, and create budgets. A student said the difficult part was how parents balance money with all their kids.
- **Skateboard Camp:** 4 youth new to 4-H, attended a Skateboarding Camp for free. Youth also engaged in traditional camp activities such as zip lining, canoeing, and TRUST Course.
