Programs At-A-Glance

- 89 farmers in Nemaha County attended agricultural meetings in 2020 to learn about pesticide safety, current agronomic practices, cover crops, soil health, and on-farm research.
- Nemaha County began Master Gardener Training in 2006. Since that time the program has trained 46 Master Gardeners.
