

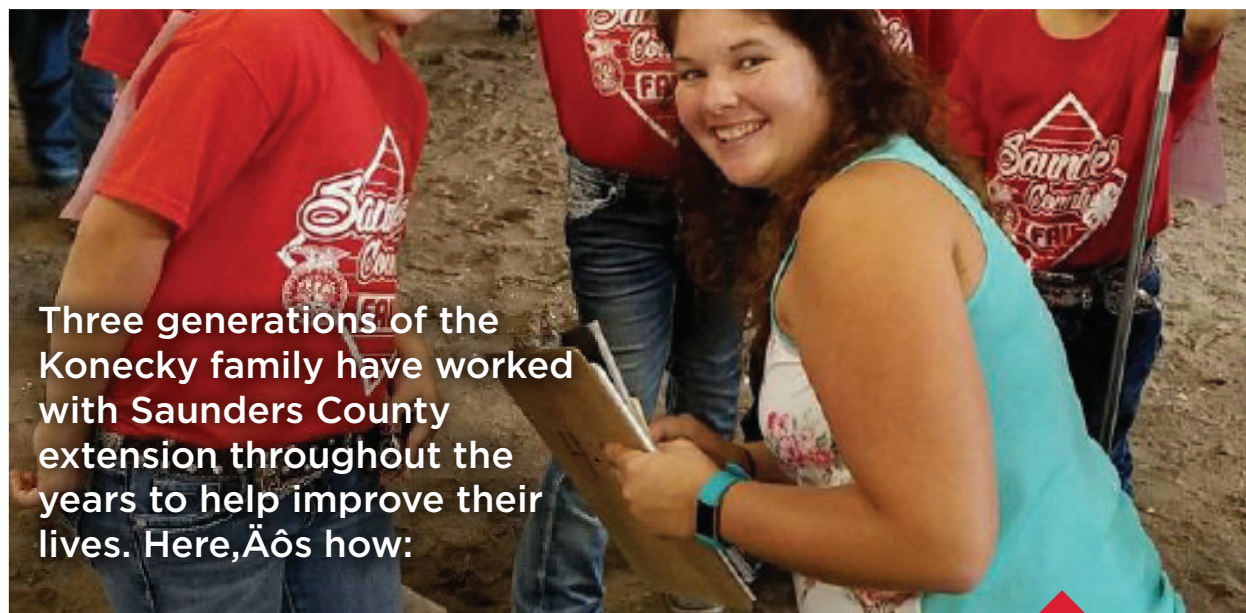
# Saunders County

### Programs At-A-Glance

- Perseverance and resilience through tough times: Saunders County 4-H engaged 1,321 youth The highlight of the year was having 1,806 projects exhibited at the Saunders County Fair
- 4-H Partners with schools and libraries: 412 youth were taught about agriculture through school enrichment and library programs focused on understanding where food comes from
