**Six hundred students across Buffalo County participated in *Life on the Farm*.**

*Life on the Farm* is a capstone Ag Literacy event for area elementary students. Students from across the county learn about Nebraska commodities and their significance to the economy and consumers. Additionally, they explore how commodities are grown, harvested, processed, and made available as goods in local grocery stores and on their tables.

### Programs At-A-Glance

*Environmental Education school enrichment programs are an outdoor themed addition to classroom education. Students participate in hands-on STEM activities on outdoor and environmental topics. 634 students learned about their environment and the importance of interacting with nature.*
