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The Ag Literacy Festival not only educates the next generation but also creates a cycle of mentorship and knowledge sharing.

The Ag Literacy Festivals have a strong statewide impact, with Madison County's 21st event serving as a prime example. This event attracted 350 students in grades 2 through 4. This year, former festival participants returned as presenters. Myranda Hansen, a 10-year 4-H member, led the dairy session. She said, "I wanted to showcase the ag industry and teach students about where their food comes from. I attended this festival as an elementary student, so it was a full-circle moment... I hope I inspired them just as I was inspired when I attended this event." Her 4-H experiences led her to study Agriculture Leadership at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
