Organizing for the county fair reduces stress. Here is an example of a "to-do" list for you to create for your family or with your own 4-Her.



- ✓June 15– turn-in animal ID sheets; make sure you're enrolled in all projects you are bringing to fair (4honline.com)
- ☑ July 8— **4-H t-shirts** to show in, available to pick-up (county contests, livestock, pets)
- ✓July 10— turn-in all exhibits you want to bring to fair on **pre-entry sheets** or online at **merrick.fairmanager.com** (so cards can be made and animal stalls assigned)
- ☐ July 13— sign-up to work a shift in the **4-H Food Stand**
- ☐ July club meeting—work with leader to take a shift for herdsmanship
- ☐ July 19– fill-out all the documents for clothing day and modeling
- ☐ July 25-27— enter all static exhibits at the 4-H building
- ☐ July 28— enter animals at the fair






