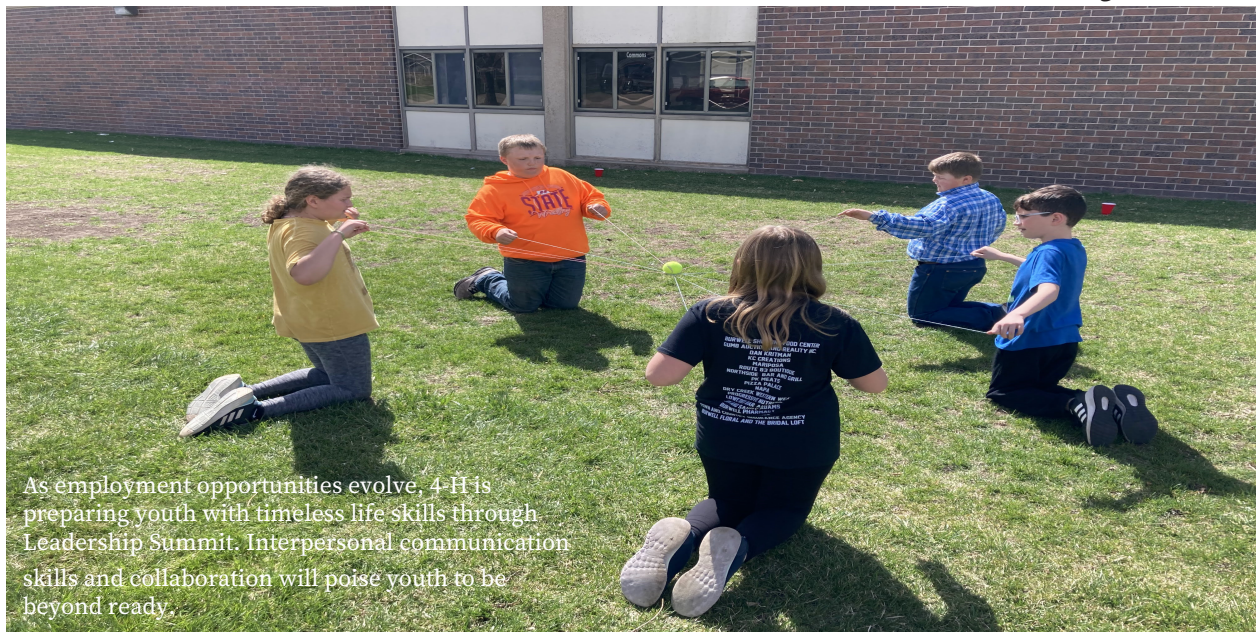


# Garfield-Loup-Wheeler Counties Impact At-A-Glance
