Citizenship Washington Focus 2024 brought together 36 youth from South Central Nebraska to participate in the National 4-H "Lead to Change" CWF Conference. Through this experience, the youth were challenged to look within their communities for ways to lead positive change. This group developed the South Central Sportsmanship Movement, which emerged from a need identified in their schools and communities to encourage others to demonstrate good sportsmanship and support students in a positive way. The program was awarded one of three national \$2,000 grants to help educate and serve as a catalyst for good sportsmanship in their communities.
