

## Keith & Arthur County 2024 Impact At-A-Glance



**331 K-12 youth were reached with school enrichment programming in Keith and Arthur County. AgSplosion was offered for the first time in 2024.**



AgSplosion engages youth in hands-on activities to learn about Nebraska commodities including corn, wheat, potatoes, beans, beef, swine, dairy, and ag technology. 140 2nd and 3rd graders attended this school enrichment program where 95% of youth learned something new about agriculture after attending. 100% of teachers said they were satisfied with the quality of educational content, and the program was engaging. One teacher shared, “I thought the experience was very informative and taught a lot of engaging material. Students seemed to enjoy learning about an integral part of our community and seeing how much of our lives are impacted by agriculture. This was awesome! I look forward to coming back.”

### Programs At-A-Glance

- *Ladybug Life Cycle: 63 youth were able to observe ladybugs through their life cycle. 95% of students know how ladybugs help farmers keep our food safe as a result of the program.*
- *Food, Nutrition, & Health: Over 50 hours of FNH programming offered in 2024.*
