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AgSplosion engages youth in hands-on activities to learn about Nebraska commodities including corn, wheat, potatoes, beans, beef, swine, dairy, and ag technology. 140 2nd and 3rd graders attended this school enrichment program where 95% of youth learned something new about agriculture after attending. 100% of teachers said they were satisfied with the quality of educational content, and the program was engaging.
