We are enhancing the lives of youth and adults in Kimball and Banner Counties by bringing UNL resources to the community. Research-based information and learning experiences provide the knowledge needed to make effective decisions, develop life skills, and improve quality of life.



Rural Prosperity Nebraska worked with the College of Architecture to bring a multidisciplinary team of 21 students to Kimball to help develop ideas for downtown revitalization, recreation, housing, and other quality-of-life needs. The fourth-year Collaborate Studio included students from architecture, interior design, and landscape architecture working together. The students engaged stakeholders in an activity to consider the needs of Kimball's current residents as well as the amenities that might retain new residents coming to the area for the Clean Harbors expansion and missile project. The class is developing a report to present to the community.

The Technology on the Ranch Roundtable provided 25 area agricultural producers with peer perspectives and research on innovations they can implement in their own operations.
