

Wayne County 2024 Impact At-A-Glance

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Expanding career options in a rapidly changing workforce makes career development an essential component of 4-H programming.



In 2024, 1,122 sophomores from 39 area high schools attended Northeast Nebraska Career Day. They are just a part of the over 20,000 students from 45 different high schools that have attended Northeast Nebraska Career Day over the last 21 years. Nebraska Extension – Wayne County partners with Wayne State College, Northeast Community College, and Northeast Nebraska Area Health Education Center to provide students with the opportunity to obtain insight about future careers which will ultimately help them achieve their dreams and aspirations. Over 80 area volunteers help provide real life career examples and advice in over 60 career areas.
