The primary goal of the Washington County 4-H Ambassador Program is building communication skills to be utilized in an advocacy role for the Washington County 4-H Program as well as in other aspects of the ambassador's life.

The Washington County 4-H Ambassadors volunteer their time to assist with a number of county, regional and state events and programs. By assisting with these functions, the Ambassadors will have opportunities to enhance their advocacy and leadership roles with the Washington County 4-H program and to develop an increased interest in volunteer work and community service.

ELIGIBILTY:

- Youth 13 15 years of age on January 1, 2025.
- Enrolled as a Washington County 4-H member.
- Must be an active member of 4-H, either independent or with a club for at least one full year prior to application.
- The program has an annual application process with an opportunity to re-apply annually if eligible.

 - Once received, a check for the scholarship amount will be sent to the 4-H Ambassador directly from the Washington County 4-H Council.
