CUT FLOWERS

A limit of 40 flower entries per exhibitor has been established.

Flowers should be placed in clear glass containers. Flower stems should have foliage, but not below the water line.

- 1. Floating Flowers(s)
- 2. Large Flower (2 inches or larger) specimens must consist of 3 assorted stems
- Small flowers (less than 2 inches) specimens must consist of 3 stems of one color or 5 assorted stems if multiple colors
- 4. Rose, 1 stem
- 5. Vine, 1 stem, 10-15 inches
- 6. Berried Branch, 1 stem, 10-15 inches
- 7. Shrub Bloom, 1 stem, 10-15 inches
- 8. Ornamental Grasses, 1-2 stems
- **9. Foliage,** 1 stem (ex. Caladium, Hosta, Coleus, Fern, Amaranthus)
- 10. Other

ARRANGEMENTS, BOUQUETS, and PLANTERS

An Arrangement is when the flowers are arranged using a frog or other stabilizer.

A Bouquet is taking the cuttings and putting them into a container "as they fall."

Arrangement:

- Coffee Break fresh or dried flowers in a cup or mug.
- **12. Miniature -** Fresh or dried flowers, 5 inches or less, including container
- **13. Most Unique Container** judging includes the plants and container
- 14. Nebraska Prairie use native Nebraska product
- **15. Novelty -** using fresh flowers and fresh vegetables
- 16. Red, White and Blue
- 17. Wreathes fresh or dried
- 18. County Fair Theme
- **19**. **Event** wedding, birthday or other
- 20. Other

Bouquets:

- 21. Dried Flower
- 22. Wildflower
- 23. Color Themed (ex. All red flowers)
- 24. Fresh
- 25. Other

Planters:

- **26. Planter -** containing established plants in container not succulents
- 27. Planter containing primarily established succulents
- 28. Hanging Basket

The Heritage Farm Award is for those farms in Nebraska that have been owned by the same family for 150 years or more.

Eligible families are urged to contact Theresa Vernon, Saline County Agricultural Society member, who will submit the nominations from this county to the state committee.

Each entry will be given an award for first, second, third, or participation. School districts receive compensation for entries to be used for the art department. Compensation will be Superior: 75 cents; Excellent: 50 cents; Good: 25 cents; Participation: none.
