1. You will receive notification of award by April 25.
2. Instructions will be provided detailing the ways you can use the scholarship funds.
3. The Dodge County 4-H Council **requires** an oral or written summary of the 4-H member's camp/workshop or educational experience, due by October 1, 2025.
4. A written thank you note to the Dodge County 4-H Council is requested from the 4-H members who are awarded scholarships.
