SALINE COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

All senior 4-H members are encouraged to apply.

- Applicant must currently be enrolled as a 4-H member of Saline County 4-H the year in which applying for a scholarship.
- . Submit the completed Saline County 4-H Scholarship application along with cumulative (<u>all years in order in ONE record</u>) 4-H Achievement and Activity Record, available at: www.saline.unl.edu AND 4-H experience story AND other required information where specified in this application for certain scholarships offered through the Saline County 4-H Council. If you have multiple years records in one book, you need to combine the records into a cumulative record. 4-H Career Portfolio recordbooks will not be accepted. You must complete and turn in the 4-H Activity and Achievement Record with your scholarship application.
- . On an attached page, explain in no more than 250 words how your experience in 4-H will help you attain your future goals.
- Preference will be given to 4-H members who have <u>active involvement/participation throughout all 4-H years</u> documented in the 4-H Achievement and Activity Record with 8 or more years (with yearly information documented in <u>one</u> 4-H Achievement and Activity Record. **Active involvement/participation throughout all 4-H years is desired**. If you have less than 8 years of 4-H involvement, we encourage you to also apply as consideration will be given to <u>active youth</u> completing the application and other required criteria.
- This application will be used to award all scholarships awarded by the Saline County 4-H Council including the Joseph Wagner Memorial Scholarship, Justin Kunc Memorial Scholarship, and the David Kujath Memorial Scholarship. Please designate on the following page which scholarships you wish to be considered for.
- . Please consider this the same as applying for a job, incomplete applications and 4-H Achievement and Activity Record will not be considered for awards.
- . You may delete the lines in the questions area and type in your information as long as you do not remove any questions and answer all questions.

Applications will not be returned. Submit this application along with your 4-H Achievement and Activity Record by <u>March 14.</u> Applications not in the office by 4:30 pm on March 14 will not be accepted.

Failure to complete all components of the application and criteria will make the applicant ineligible for any scholarships.

Dave Kujath Memorial Scholarship Criteria – Complete only if eligible based on criteria

Applicants MUST meet <u>ALL</u> of the following criteria to be awarded the full \$500. If some but not ALL criteria are met the scholarship may be awarded and the amount reduced to \$250.

- 1. Be an enrolled Saline County 4-H member <u>(FFA not eligible)</u> at the time the scholarship is awarded. Must be enrolled in a two-year or four-year college at the time the scholarship is disbursed with proof of enrollment.
- 2. Have been enrolled in the 4-H Beef project at least 4 years AND have exhibited a 4-H beef project at the Saline County Fair for a minimum of 4 years.
- 3. Must have submitted the county approved annual 4-H Achievement and Activity Record required for each of those 4 years. FFA recordbooks are not accepted.
- 4. Must be an <u>active and enrolled member</u> of a 4-H club who has completed 4-H club or individual community service projects noted in your 4-H Achievement and Activity Record required at the time of submission.
- 5. 500-word essay explaining:
 - 1. Why your 4-H experience has been important to you and the impact 4-H participation has made in your life and your future goals.
 - 2. How raising or exhibiting beef projects has impacted your life?
 - 3. Why do you feel it is important to give back to your community through volunteer service?
