
Holiday Fundraiser

It's that time of year again! Letters and order forms for the 2025 Holiday Fundraiser have been mailed to all 4-H families in October, so please let us know if you did not receive your fundraising information.

There are some exciting new popcorn flavors and sizes available, along with the popular favorites from previous years, that would make great holiday gift items! The hot chocolate and coffee vendor is no longer available, so thanks to Jeanne Scheuneman for locating a tasty new option: MinDee's Nuts!

As an added incentive this year, 4-H families that participate in the Holiday Fundraiser by selling at least \$50 worth of items, or donating \$50, and enroll in Colfax County 4-H by April 1st, 2026 will be registered for a drawing with multiple prizes.


