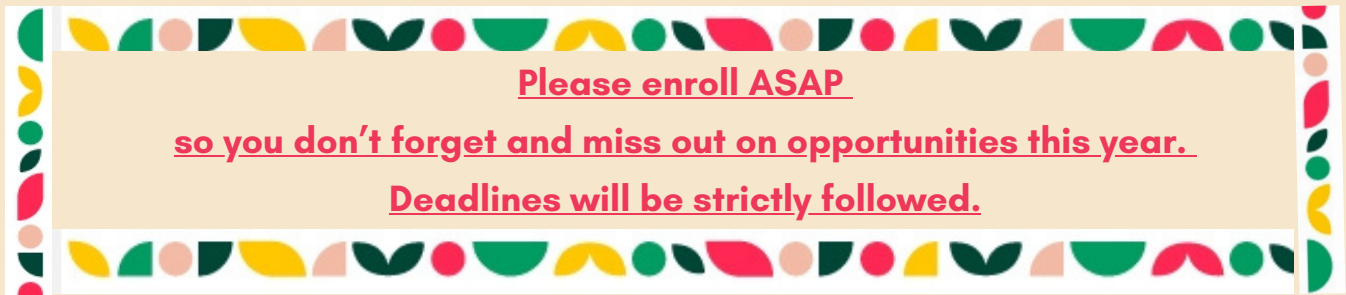

However, if you are doing SHOOTING SPORTS, you need to select those projects so you can sign an additional Parental Consent Form. If those forms are not signed, youth will not be able to practice until they are signed!
