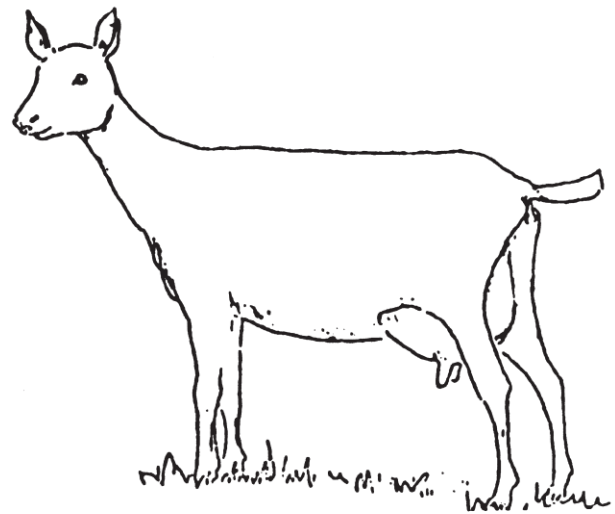
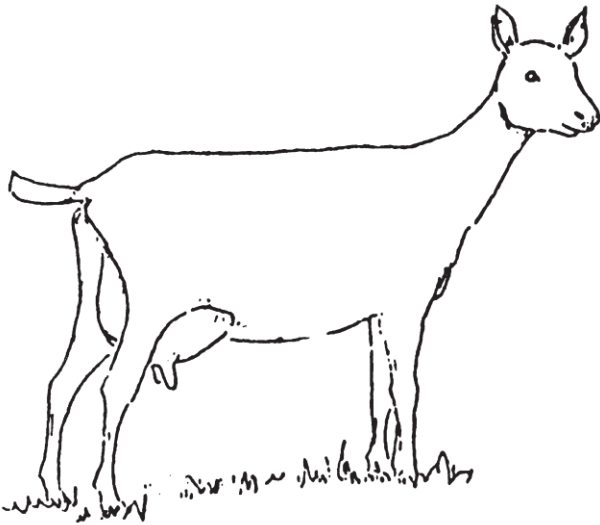

**4-H & FFA Animal Exhibitor and Animal
Project Regulations**

Age of Exhibitor

4-H - Eligibility is determined based on the 4-H age. 4-H age is the age of the youth before January 1 of the current year (the age of the member on December 31 of the previous year). The first year of eligibility for the regular 4-H program and State Fair is the 4-H age of eight (8). The last year of eligibility is 4-H age of eighteen (18).

FFA - Only bona fide Nebraska FFA members that have paid dues shall be eligible for FFA Division entries. Members may retain their active membership until the 30th day of November following the fourth National FFA Convention, which occurs after the member graduates from or leaves high school. There will be no discrimination because of race, color, sex, religion, or national origin.

Animal Ownership

All dairy or dairy goat project animals must be owned:

- a. solely by the 4-H exhibitor, or FFA exhibitor
- b. the exhibitor in partnership with other member(s) of his or her immediate family.
 - a. All exhibitor family member names may be on the animal identification sheet and will be eligible to show that animal.
 - b. Immediate family is defined as members of a household, including parents, brothers and sisters, and youth in the care of the head of the household.
- c. by someone outside the immediate family, but identified by the exhibitor, provided the exhibitor manages (cares for, feeds, trains, grooms, etc.), has use of the animal as a 4-H project animal at least 75 percent of the time during the project year and permission for the use of the animal is certified in the owner's affidavit (below).
- d. registered animals owned by someone outside the immediate family must be registered to the same person or farm name as listed in the owner's affidavit below. The exhibitor must have registration papers available at the show for inspection by the show superintendent.

Registration Papers

Registration papers must show one of the following:

- a. the member's name as owner, or
- b. the name of the exhibitor and/or a co-owner who is a member of the exhibitor's immediate family (see immediate family definition above), or
- c. the family farm or ranch name or parent's name.
- d. registered animals owned by someone outside the immediate family must be registered to the same person or farm name as listed in the owner's affidavit below. The exhibitor must have registration papers available at the show for inspection by the show superintendent.

Identification of Animals

All animals must be individually identified, listed on the appropriate form and on file in the local extension office or with the local FFA chapter and general FFA superintendent. Please confirm with your local extension office or local FFA chapter your county identification deadlines.
