College Scholarship Application



Applicant Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a current High School Senior or College Freshman.
2. Applicant must currently be an enrolled member of the Dodge County 4-H Program. Therefore, the applicant may not be older than 18 years of age on January 1 of the current calendar year.
3. Application must be completed and returned with proper signatures to the Nebraska Extension in Dodge County Office by April 7 of the current calendar year. After submission, applications will not be returned.
4. Notification of selection committee results will be made after May 1 of the current calendar year.

Judging Criteria:

Dodge County 4-H Council members will appoint a selection committee.

1. 60% based upon the applicant's 4-H projects and activities.
2. 25% based upon the applicant's non-4-H activities and involvement.
3. 15% based upon the applicant's past contributions and future involvement in 4-H and their communities.

Scholarship Information:

1. TWO \$500 college scholarships in the name of Dodge County 4-H Council will be offered.
2. Scholarship recipients will be required to send a photo upon request.
3. Scholarship will be awarded after receiving written notification of scholarship recipient's second semester enrollment. Included in this notification will be:
 - a. Letter requesting scholarship
 - b. Copy of class schedule for second semester classes
4. Scholarship monies will be sent directly to the scholarship winner.
